



# OVERVIEW OF PLANNING PROCESSES FOR ADELBERT MOUNTAINS PROJECT AREA


## Community-based processes (with each community/clans)

- 50,000ha covered by LUMP, includes 15,000 ha conservation forest
- 3% gross revenue supports forest management costs



# Jurisdictional Approaches to Green Development

- **Planning and understanding the context**
  - Resource community engagement (Community Buy-in)
  - Participatory land use planning
  - Conservation Agreement
- **Institutionalisation of Plan**
  - Work with Local Government on ward development planning
  - Support Local Organisations with tools and processes
- **Resource Mobilisation**
  - Work with Government supporting policy formulation and development to invest in NRM
  - Work with private sector to promote sustainable resource use through formal agreements
- **Implementation**
  - Promote community learning and training networks
  - Support Technical Working Groups at National levels
- **Evaluation**
  - Support Conservation Advisory Committee on planning and reviewing work plans
  - Support Local Level Government on planning and implementation of conservation plans
  - Facilitate Land Owner Conferences

# Challenges!!!



1. Reduced management capacity at local community level
2. Quick fix solutions (Brown vs Green Economies)
3. Policy and Legislative support by the Government
4. Funding support (Beyond 2014???)
