# **Migrating Old Projects**

 If you had an account on the old GLWMS interface, your projects saved before 2/17/17 are available in the new interface. To migrate projects created in the old interface after that, select My Projects > Migrate Old Projects.

### **View Current Payment Rates**


- Select Current Program Payments from the map menu. This will display current payment information for the Saginaw Bay RCPP, and the Saginaw Bay Pay for Performance Programs (sediment and groundwater).

### **Drawing Field Boundaries**

- If you're drawing a field boundary and make a mistake, hit the Escape button on your keyboard. This will cancel out what you've drawn so far so you can quickly restart.
   If you already outlined a field boundary but made a mistake, you can edit it using the button and adjusting the vertices as needed.
- If you need to remove one or more field boundaries from the map, select Draw Fields > Clear All Drawings.

### Measure Tool

- Select Measure from the map. A window will open with three measuring options: area, distance and location.
- To activate the measurement tool, select one of the options from the window.
- Click on the map to start measuring. For area and distance measurements, you
  must double-click when you're ready to complete the measurement.
- IMPORTANT: When you're done measuring, click on the measurement tool you
  were using to turn it off. Otherwise, you may go to pan the map and find that the
  measurement tool is still active.



### **Edit/View Old Projects**

- Select My Projects > View/Edit Projects and browse until you find the project of interest. Select like for the project OR simulation you'd like to edit. Then modify and save details as needed.
- If you want to review past results, click Load Simulation after you've selected a project and simulation. This will
  zoom to the field(s) associated with the simulation. For RCPP Evaluations, select the RCPP Wizard from the map
  menu and navigate to the results tab. For all other evaluations, select Analysis Wizards > General Wizard
  navigate to the Results tab.
